

he Florida Department of Health is pleased to announce its partnership with the Commission on Dental Competency Assessments (CDCA) and Miami Dade College to offer a special administration of the American Board of Dental Examiners (ADEX) licensing examination for dentists from Puerto Rico or the United States Virgin Islands who are seeking licensure in Florida.

This special administration of the ADEX dental examination will be held on February 10-12, 2018 at Miami Dade College exclusively for dentists who have fled Puerto Rico or the United States Virgin Islands. Please contact the Florida Board of

Dentistry to reserve your slot as space is limited. The cost of this examination has also been drastically reduced to \$500 saving those most affected by Hurricanes Maria and Irma over \$1,700. This is a one-time special rate and cannot carry over for the June 2018 regularly scheduled exam. There is also an additional facility fee charged by Miami Dade College of approx. \$350.

This partnership is designed to help those dentists who have fled Puerto Rico or the United States Virgin Islands following the devastation from Hurricanes Maria and Irma that need to satisfy the examination requirement for licensure in Florida as a dentist.
